



Observer report for 10th Birthday Tournament of Magyar mah-jong szövetség (Hungarian MJ Association (MCR, MERS 1))

Participants: 20 players

Represented Countries: Hungary 15, Austria 5

Playing schedule: 2 days, 7 rounds (4+3) of 120 minutes

Location: The room was large enough to host the players and leave enough space between them.

Equipment: The tables had the right size, very comfortable chairs, good lighting, the room was well conditioned

Refereeing: Otto Myslivec and Norbert Tschinkel (players)

Complaints: None relating to the tournament.

Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock projected from a computer on a screen. The start and the end of sessions were marked clearly. Ranking up to date between each session via projection.

Sessions: Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: Lunch in a nearby restaurant

Prizes: Trophies for individual ranking (1st, 2nd and 3rd), little presents for the round-winners, but also for the round-losers. Every player got a certificate.

Conclusion: Very nice tournament in Dunaföldvár. Aside the tournament “Murphy’s Law” ruled. „Whatever can go wrong will go wrong“...illness of players, ... the outcome of this were delays... the outcome of this were problems with the catering... a window crashed during playing...etc. but everybody stayed in a good mood.
