Information / Communication: a TV screen + voice announcements

Prizes: trophies for individual ranks 1st, 2nd, 3rd; special nominations for the largest table win and largest deal-in, special nomination "The 4th one" for largest score after not winning a single hand in a table.

Yakuman hands completed: one — Chinrouto (all terminals). This one decided two of the special prizes.
