Visible clock projected from a computer on a screen. A gong clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session, beamed in the playing room.

Catering: Lunch in the same place (salad, wraps, desserts), drinks and others. A special bus took us to another place at the end of the day for a nice dinner (cassoulet), with magicians and a jazz orchester. It was a very nice evening.
