

## Observer report for 11<sup>th</sup> Hungarian Mah Jong Open – Sisi Cup Part II (MCR, MERS 2)

**Participants:** 56 players, from 12 countries: Hungary (12 players), France (9), Austria (6), Belgium (5), Denmark (5), Italy (5), Russia (5), Switzerland (4), Sweden (2), Germany (1), Netherlands (1), United Kingdom (1).

Playing schedule: 2 days, 7 rounds (4+3) of 120 minutes

**Location:** The Sporttelep is a nice place, easy to reach. The "new" room is very large to host 14 tables and more.

**Equipment:** We played with standard game sets (without numbers) and non-bordered tables, just a bit little.

Refereeing: Pal Halasz was non-player referee.

Complaints: None.

## Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock projected from a computer on a screen. A gong clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session, projected on the screen.

**Sessions:** Excellent playing atmosphere.

**Catering:** Lunch in the same place on Saturday and Sunday, with a warm generous buffet.

**Prizes:** Trophies for individual ranking (1st, 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup>), for the round winners (best score in each session), for the places between 4 to 10 and for the last player. Trophies for the best three of the Sisi Cup.

**Conclusion:** Very nice tournament, well-organised and with people really interesting to necessities of the players, in particular abroad players.
