**Participants:** 5 countries, 44 players: Latvia (1), Austria (2), Netherlands (3), Italy (4), Russia (34).

**Playing schedule:** 3 days, 11 rounds (4+4+3) of 120 minutes.

**Location:** Russia, Saint-Petersburg, Lermontovskiy prospekt, 43/1, AZIMUT Hotel Saint-Petersburg ★★★, hall with panoramic view of city of Saint-Petersburg.

**Equipment:** We played with different games on excellent special made hand crafted table-tops.

**Refereeing:** Aleksei Shpilman was non-player referee.

**Complaints:** None.

### **Information / communication during the tournament:**

Visible clock on multiple large monitor screens on the wall. A gong clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session and displayed on the monitors on the wall.

**Sessions:** Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

**Catering:** Drinks and small snacks in same room. Lunch (self) locations in hotel or other restaurants nearby, indicated on map provided.

**Prizes:** Trophies for rank 1, 2, 3 and presents for rank 4 and 5.

**Conclusion:** Very nice tournament in Saint-Petersburg, with beautiful view over city while playing. It is a pity there are not more players of the bordering countries.
