Playing schedule: 2 days, 9 rounds (5+4) of 120 minutes

Location: 33 Rue Blanche, 75009, Paris. Two spacious rooms available and a terrace. One room for playing and one for breaks.

Equipment: mah-jong tiles, junk mats and square tables. Sheets for recoding results.

Refereeing: Yulong ZHAO was non-player referee.

Complaints: None.

Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock projected on a computer screen. A gong clearly informing players of the start and the ending of sessions. Ranking updated between each session, available for viewing on computer.

Sessions: Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: soft drinks, tea, coffee plus snacks available throughout the two days. Lunch for both days was offered at a nearby Indian restaurant located within a few minutes walking distance from the tournament. Breakfast was available on Sunday.

Prizes: Trophies for individual ranking (1st, 2nd and 3rd), Best French player and additional special prizes.

Conclusion: Good tournament location, very central, easy access from the metro. Well organised, great host. Everything well taken care of and a fun and exciting concluding ceremony with additional special prizes.
