Participants: 24 players

Represented countries:

-Sweden: 14 -France: 5 -Switzerland: 3 -Denmark: 1 -Spain: 1

Playing schedule: 2 days, 7 rounds (4+3) of 120 minutes.

Location: Bridgen Hus Uppsala. The place is large enough to host players and leave space between them.

Equipment: Impeccable tables and sets and comfortable seats.

Refereeing: Astrid Dubedout was non player referee.

Complaints: Not a single one.

Information/communication during the tournament: Visible clock was projected on a big screen. A gong clearly informs the players of the start and the end of sessions and the referee announced the "15 minutes remaining". Ranking was projected too on a big screen during all the tournament.

Sessions: Excellent playing atmosphere: FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: Lunches, drinks (coffee, tea and water) and others available. Other drinks available for a small fee.

Prices: Top 3, best Swede and 3 special prices (biggest hand, highest round and most mahjongs in a round).

Conclusion: Very nice tournament with an efficient organizing team.
