Location: Hageveld college in Heemstede. Separate rooms for playing and for lunch, both big enough to seat 92 competition players and 76 recreative players

Complaints: None.

Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock on a computer screen. A gong clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session, printed and posted on walls.

Sessions: Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: Lunch in the same place (sandwiches and soup), drinks and others

Prizes: Trophies for individual ranking (1st, 2nd and 3rd), one for place 12 as it was the 12th edition, one for place 14 (Valentinesprize) and 1 for the last place and one for selfdrawn Bamboo Eight

Conclusion: Very nice tournament in Heemstede, in a large venue with a very good athmosphere
