Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock projected from a computer on a pull-down screen. A gong clearly informs players of the start and the end of sessions. Ranking up to date between each session on the same screen as the clock.

Sessions: Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

Catering: Lunch, snacks and drinks between rounds on both days at the playing venue.

Prizes: Trophies for individual ranking (1st through 3rd).

Conclusion: Excellent tournament with a nice mix of new players and veterans.
