## Information / communication during the tournament:

Visible clock from a computer screen. A gong clearly informs players of the start and a ringtone from the computer informs of the end of sessions. Ranking updated between each session, posted on facebook and visible on the computer screen.

**Sessions:** Excellent playing atmosphere, FFF (Fair-play, Friendly and Fun).

**Catering:** Meals were served in the hotel's restaurant, during breaks snacks and drink were offered.

**Prizes:** Trophies (Austrian specialties) for individual ranking (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>), for the best and the worse players of each round, for referees (who also have organized the tournament) and observer.

**Conclusion:** Very nice and well organized tournament in Strassburg, as usual. One player signed up for mistake, he was convinced it was a Richii tournament so he was surprised/ confused when he realized that he didn't know MCR rules, but all the players were been helpful and understanding.
